


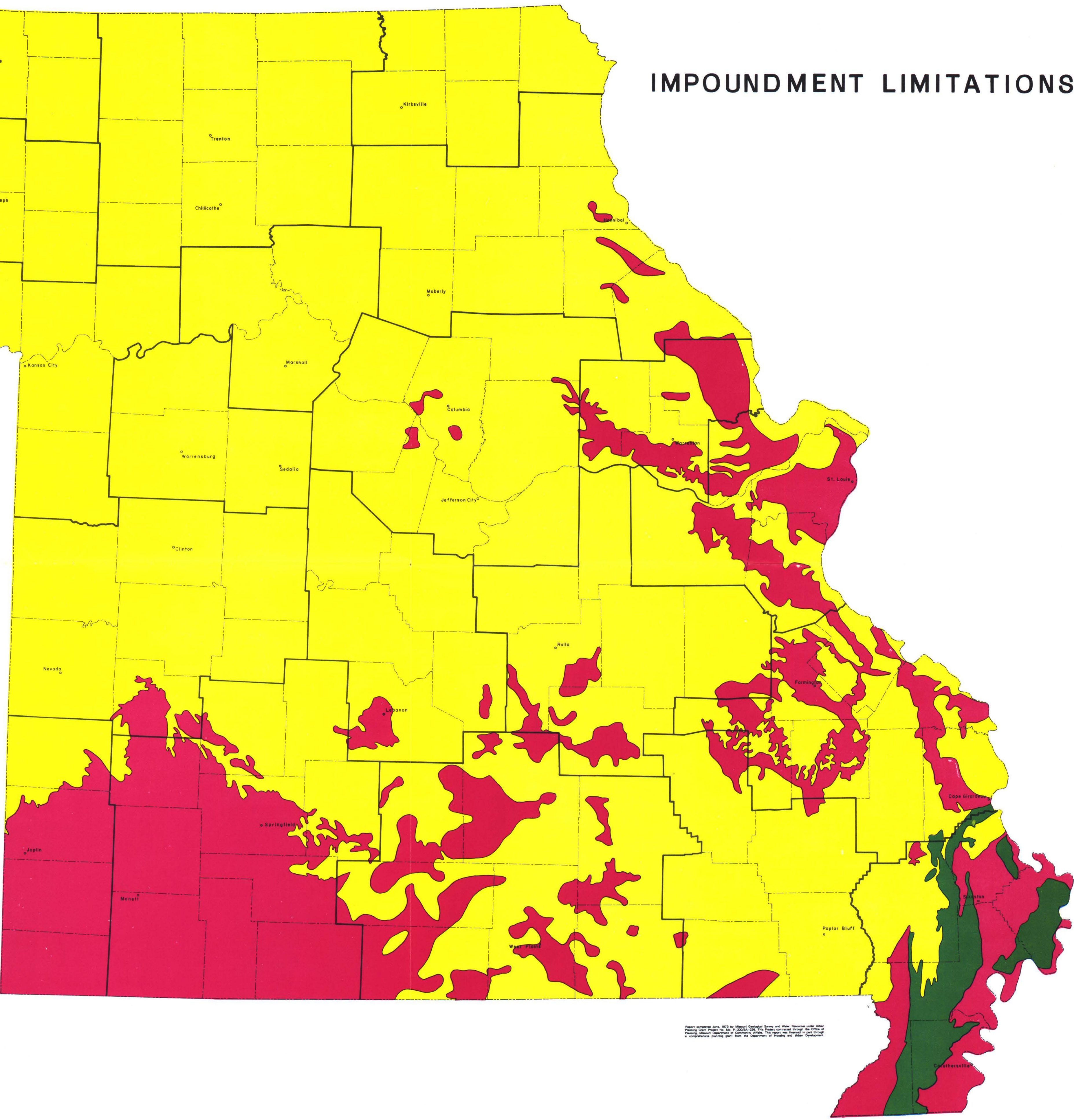


IMPOUNDMENT LIMITATIONS

-  Few or no engineering geology problems; economic feasibility almost assured.
-  A fair number of engineering geology problems exist, but usually they can be solved by adequate engineering design; construction of facility usually economically feasible, but sometimes may be marginal.
-  Many or complex engineering geology problems exist that require sophisticated engineering investigation and design; some areas may then still be considered unsuitable; economic feasibility doubtful except in cases of extreme need.



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
